Important cases Charles Roach v The Procurator Fiscal Paisley and The Chief Constable of Argyll and Clyde Established a new law on the removal of historic and malicious complaints of sexual assault from the police records of those accused but never prosecuted, with the effect of removing bars to employment.
Goodwin o Established that the statute bar to appeal is not fixed in time but even after three years, when able to secure proper counsel, previous convictions can be overturned and roles in the security industry can be restored.
Osunkwo o Established new protocols for dealing with summary offences when reissuing security industry certificates, enabling those with regrettable out-of-character summary convictions to renew their licences.
 Khandoker Numbers 1 & 2 Established that an insurer who cancels the policy but retains the premium is still an insurer for the purposes of the road traffic laws.
 Filipek Established that the police national register is not always correct and even when a driver is reported for no licence if DVLA produces one, the live check and roadside checks are not definitive in court. (won on appeal)
 Revil Established new procedures for prosecuting minor drug offences, and confirmed that schedule one does not apply to drug offences and football banning orders.
Porter-Cross v Secretary of State for Work and Pensions (Child Maintenance) o Established a new protocol that a judge may make a finding that a child resided with one parent despite the other parent receiving a child allowance. Won on appeal against a Member of Parliament.
 Bromfield v Munson A Football Association defamation case establishes part 18 of the civil procedural rules as a valid tool for overcoming complex defamation cases against public officials, without the expense and risk of full-blown proceedings.
 Jenkinson Fox and Duckworth v Crown ex parte Duke of Devonshire Established that criminal damage against wildlife should be properly prosecuted under the law and by a finding of abuse of process, dismissed the crown's case against a group of off-roader club members on an area of special scientific importance.
Brown v Secretary of State for Work and Pensions o Established that claimants of DLA who cannot speak should be afforded protection under the law from unfair decisions and claimants suffering from speech and affective disorders or communication disabilities should be given automatic routes to provide evidence through supported means when making applications.
Arber ex Parte York magistrates court – sitting in Leeds o Established that where an allegation of fraud is raised, the locus is the place the moving vehicle in this case a train departed from and not the locus of the offence, where the

jurisdiction of the court is being argued.

- o Further established that a passenger who offers a railcard for payment during a journey at the first opportunity, having been unable to purchase a ticket earlier is not de facto in breach of the rules and laws concerning purchasing a ticket before travelling. won on appeal.
- Oladipupo Chester magistrates court
- o Established that the late filing of disclosure of the driver of a vehicle is not a bar to reopening a conviction where the offending driver refuses to admit the offnce.
